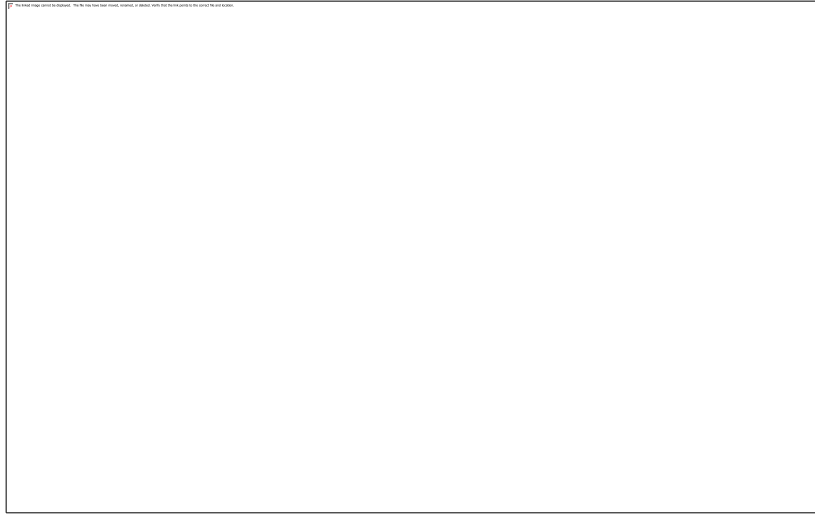


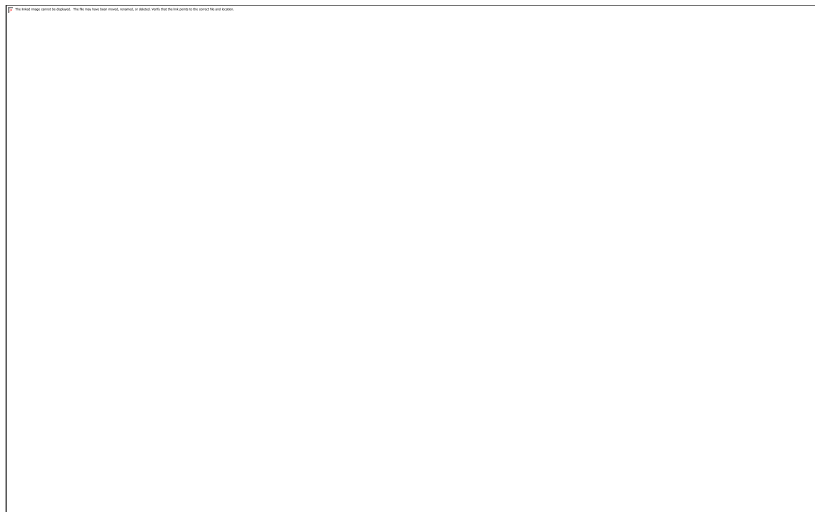
Dat Viet Editor-in-Chief visits DTU
