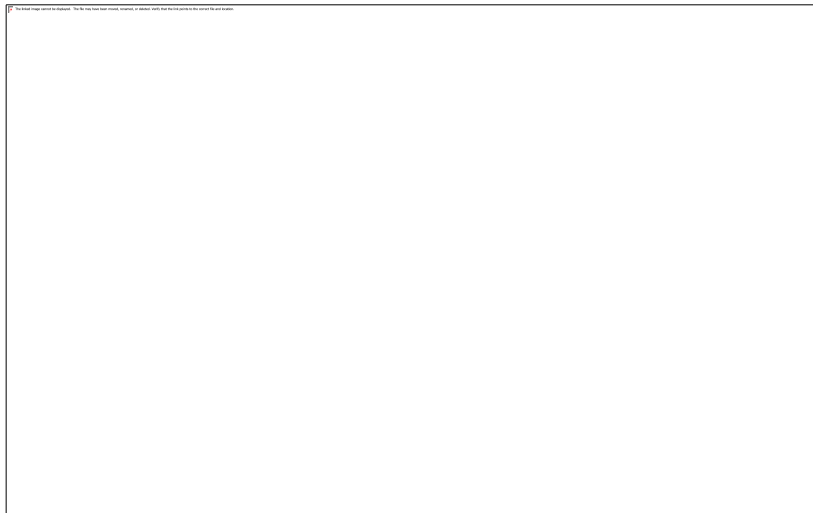


Helping the Underprivileged
