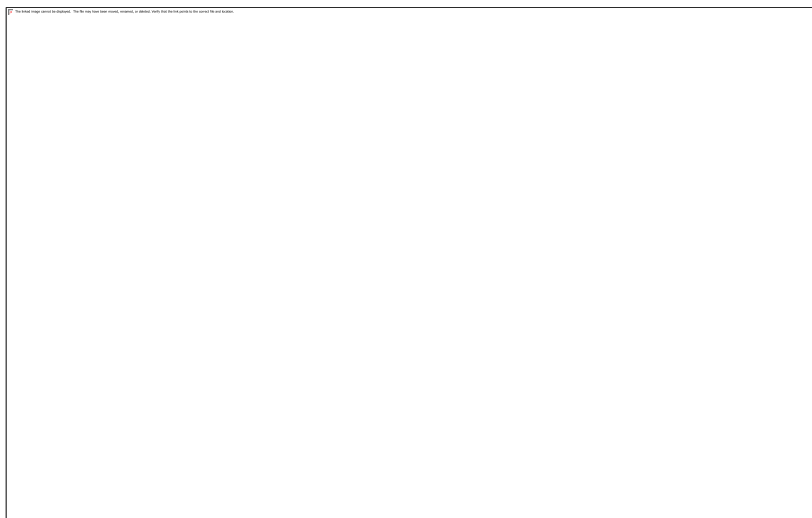


The Opening of the 2010 “Volunteer Teaching” Orphan Program
