Under our agreement, DTU will send faculty to teach English to our staff and the Sandy Beach Resort will offer students part-time and full-time jobs, as well as internships”.

Ms. Ha Thi Lien, Manager of Personnel at Sandy Beach enthusiastically replied to student questions, especially from students of the Department of Hospitality and Tourism, who are preparing internships. She said: “This agreement will create more internship opportunities for DTU at Sandy Beach Resort. In addition, we favor recruiting permanent staff who have already been working on probation at the resort. An internship is a really good way of gaining valuable experience for future full-time jobs. Students who succeed during their two-month internships will then be able to work full-time at Sandy Beach”.
