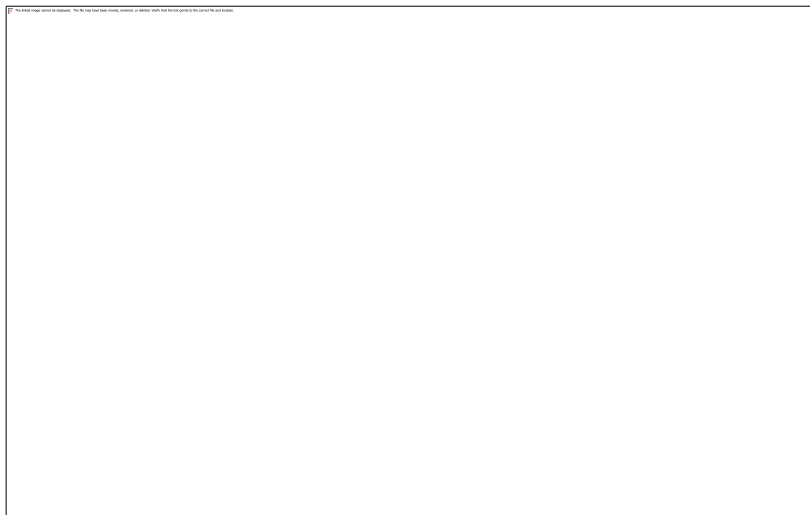


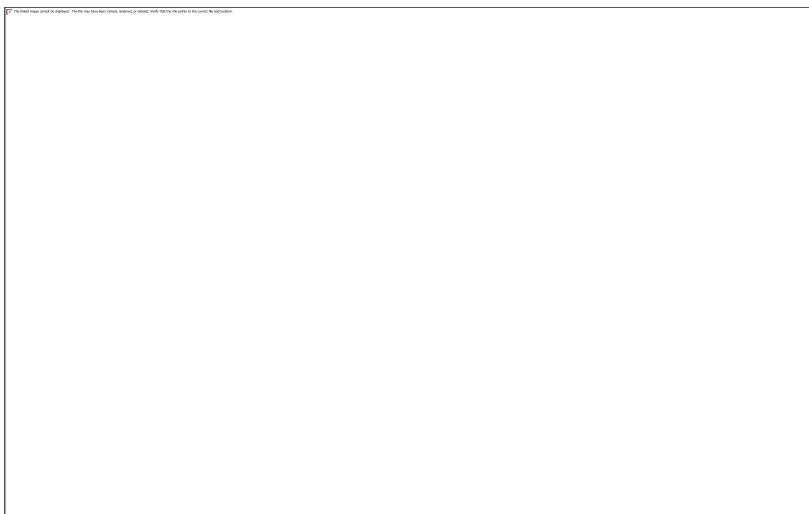
Visiting Lecturers at DTU
